Türkiye

- Capital: Ankara
- Area: 783,600km²
- Population: 76,668,000
- Located across Europe and Asia
- Borders the Mediterranean Sea, the Aegean Sea and the Black Sea
- After Alexander the Great's conquest, the area was Hellenized which continued with the Roman rule and the transition into the Byzantine Empire. Many ancient Buildings can be visited by tourists nowadays

İstanbul

- Population: 14.200.000
- biggest city in Turkey and known as the country's economic, cultural, and historical heart
- Separated by the Bosphorus into an Asian and a European part

İzmir

- Population: 4.005.000
- Third most populous city in Turkey, after Istanbul and Ankara
- Many famous and important universities were established there
- Near the coast, easy to reach because of a big airport and ancient buildings: favored by tourists

Nazilli

- Population: 111.000
- located in the southwest of Turkey in the province of Aydın, beside (next to) Aydın City, the only big city in the province
- 100km away from the sea
- Much of the countryside is a mix of fig, olive and citrus trees
